Subject: Fw: Orr Conservation Land Blazing

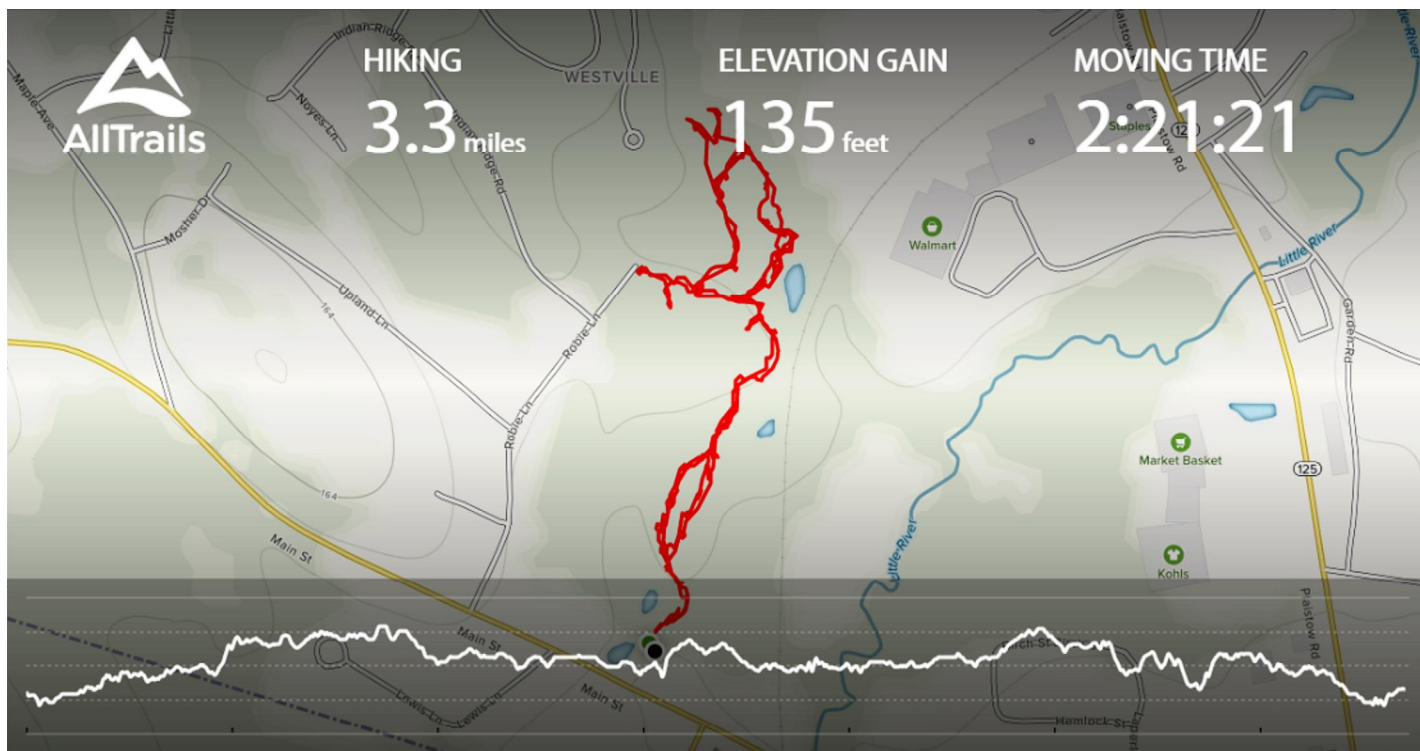
Took advantage of the nice weather this afternoon and blazed the primary trail at Orr Conservation Land (Community Center). The trails (logging roads) were much better defined without the snow of earlier March examination. The primary trail blazed in Yellow is basically two loops, the second one I bushwhacked for added interest...wet lands marsh, stream and pond. There are several opportunities for branch trails (will be blazed in red) off the primary. One branch will lead up to another entry point, another up to a nice clearing/meadow...great space for a boy scout jamboree, plus a couple of logging roads loops that branch off the primary trail. The trails require some chain saw maintenance, but overall not in too bad of shape after the winter snows and heavy winds...good scout project for clearing some debris. The first part of the primary trail could be a suitable base for handicap activities...wheel chairs, etc...if properly graded and applied surface preparation. I will be off salmon fishing the remainder of week; plan to branch blaze (red) the remaining trail upon return next week. I think the Orr trails after blazing and cleanup are completed will provide some excellent hiking opportunities for the community...plenty of parking!!
