Pete,

Completed the blazing of Crown Hill in yellow yesterday. As shown on the Alltrails map the trail forms a huge "C" shape route. Due to the length and nature of the trail, I added two "exit" points where the hiker can get off the trail and back on to the primary return trail back to the parking lot. The trail is very windy, back and forth and becomes a bit tedious. Point of interest, the town boundary line portion of the trail (yellow blaze) leads (after the primary trail turning east) to an interesting, historical marker (red blaze)...an engraved rock designating the intersection of three town boundaries...Atkinson, Plaistow and Hampstead. Unfortunately, the marker has been spray painted Red by someone which detracts from its historical character. Pictures are include in the Alltrails link. This tri-town marker is off set from the GPS boundary line coordinates...I searched the GPS coordinates for a new, 1940 granite marker (as established on East Rd at the corner of road to the trail head). Wandered around, but could not find it if it was there. In that area there was an old gravel, elongated borrow pit that was used long ago.

Overall the trails are in good condition, little or no maintenance needed and have shown some recent traffic. In my wandering, I have yet to locate the "Noyes Rock", probably need a picture!!

On to Pine Knoll section, so far "bugs" are not an issue!
