The Crown Hill-Noyes new trailhead is excellent...new road entrance with at least 6 parking slots. Trail entrance is well defined. The straight ahead trail is in good shape and is parallel to the Atkinson/Hampstead town line. It continues to the Atkinson/Plaistow town corner and then follows the Atkinson/Plaistow town line southeast and then circles back to the beginning. The return portion of the trail is not well defined and needs to be cleared and expanded. Trails continues at the corner and at the return into the Plaistow trail system in the Southeast Land Trust of NH (www.seltnh.org). Trail loop is approximately 3/4 mile and requires blazing.
