Marshall Trust Land Assessment Notes Marshall Trust Land...Industrial Way Road

3/25/16....50 deg Sunny, slight breeze with residual ice

The forest lot is located parallel to the end of Industrial Way. I entered at the end of the lot over large stones bulldozed near the lot boundary. My intent was to located any trails or field roads that could be followed. I proceeded to the NW along the boundary stone wall making a large loop. The terrain consists on several small hill, ravines and depressions currently frozen over. No trails, game trails, or field roads detected. No stone walls crossed this tract of land other than the boundary stone wall that parallels the Industrial Way road. Upon return to start point I finally found an old field road near the corner of the Trust lot. This road proceeded SE below a group of houses on a ridge above. Retracing this field road back into the Marshall land but disappeared with brushes, small trees, etc. It appears it followed a small stream that cuts diagonally thru the land trust. At the SE corner of the trust lot there is a old field road that appears to go up into the bulldozed cleared area in the industrial park area.
