Pete,

I went back to the Marshall Land trails to Blue blaze an upper loop and also check a few details (cross trails) on Stickney. While at Marshall I took the opportunity to walk the Marshall Nature Trail which is the primary loop trail I had blazed in White. All the station posts have been knocked over but some are still near the original site. I looked for the three "hard scape" landmarks vs trees, etc. All three were found and in excellent condition since first described in a 1985 trail diagram. Station 1: 1741 Atkinson/Hampstead granite boundary marker; Station 3: A huge granite stone that was "cut" for house foundation; Station 11: Large pile of stones from field clearing. See photos of each by clicking on the AllTrails link below the photo below (A/H town marker shown to the left). Also included in the photos is the Luther Chase cellar hole near trail head. Found the Marshall Land Trails sign post with Nature Trail diagram in the Chase homestead foundation also near the trail head.

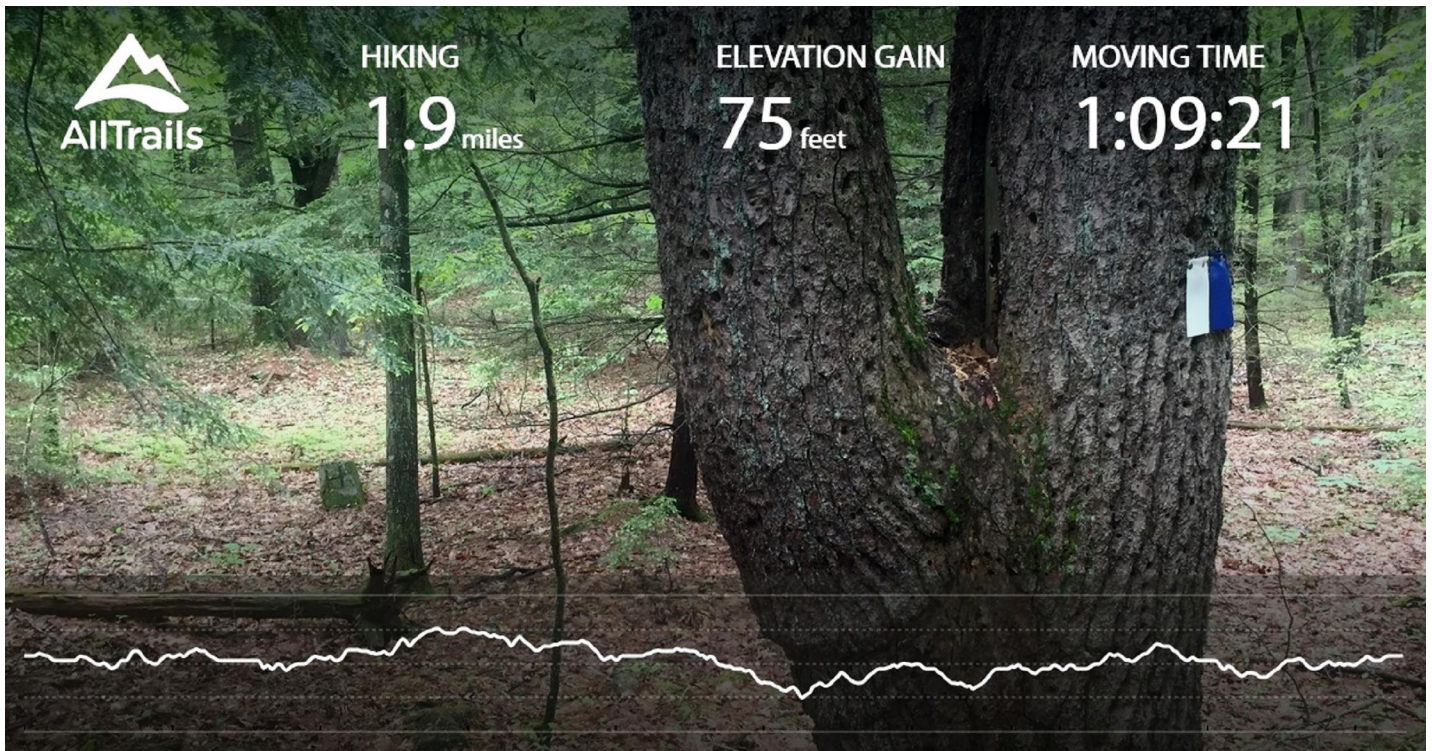
The Stickney branch trails blazed in Blue will be in second e-mail.
